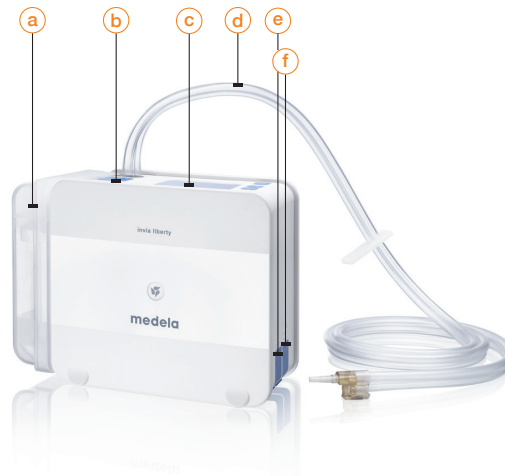

Contraindications



Do not use Invia Liberty for patients with any of the following conditions:

- Necrotic tissue with eschar present


- Do not place Invia Wound Therapy Dressing over exposed blood vessels or organs.
